The Opportunity

Staff working with youth are in an opportune position to provide sexual and reproductive health (SRH) information and access to care.

The Challenge

Youth may not get the SRH information or care they need, if organizations do not guide staff about their role in providing SRH support to youth.

The Solution



Create clear SRH policies and best practices.



Train staff to build knowledge and skills.



Place SRH materials in the environment.

The Impact

Staff feel **prepared** and more positive about providing SRH information and connecting youth to care.

Staff **transform agency environment** with books, posters, brochures, and other resources.

Staff **communicate** nonjudgmental, accurate information that youth can use to make **healthy decisions**.
